

**PAST LT. GOVERNORS' ASSOCIATION
NEBRASKA-IOWA DISTRICT
District Convention
Lincoln, Nebraska
August 7, 1999**

Association Vice-President Robert Gingery called the meeting to order in the absence of Association President Marvin Hibben. Gingery called meeting to order at 4:15 PM.

Past Lt. Gov. Richard Slama gave the invocation.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Association Secretary Alan Cox.

A report of membership was given by Alan Cox. It was stated that all past lieutenant governors were automatically members as soon as they had served their term in office. We considered them members as long as they were Kiwanis members. It was again stated that we hoped the Past Lt. Governors would pay their dues but because of the low dues rate we could not afford to send dunning letters. The number of Past Lt. Governors was asked and could not be given from memory. There are 480.

Motions made and seconded to accept all three reports. Carried.

It was urged that the association continue placing news articles, as well as minutes, about the organization in the district bulletin.

Acceptance of the reported was moved and supported. Motion carried.

Treasurer Alan Cox presented to the association membership the financial report. He reported the association was in good shape. He mentioned the account balances at the time for the checks and savings account. He mentioned that the association had a \$1,000 certificate of deposit. The association had a balance of \$25 in the checking account, \$284 in the savings account and a \$1,000 certificate of deposit with Iowa State Bank of Hull, Orange City and Sheldon, Iowa.

Association member Carol Ann Rathman upon conclusion of the financial moved that the Nebraska-Iowa Kiwanis Past Lt. Governor's Association contribute \$500 toward the Steve Siemens campaign for Kiwanis International Trustee. Motion made, and unanimous consent was given to make that contribution.

An extensive report was given to the association about efforts being made to have each division represented by a past Lt. Gov in the association.

Secretary-Treasurer Alan Cox read to the association's membership from Don Glenn, Secretary-Treasurer of the Nebraska-Iowa Kiwanis District Foundation.

It was moved and supported that the association send out a reminder to the membership about the association.

Association Vice-President Robert Gingery asked if there was any further business, and a benediction was given to close the meeting. There were forty members present at this afternoon's meeting.

Meeting was closed at 5:00 PM.
